Congressman Chris Murphy is the freshman representative from Connecticut's 5th district. In November of 2006, Congressman Murphy upset 12 term incumbent Nancy Johnson, winning 54% of the vote, in one of the most closely watched races in the country.

Congressman Murphy currently serves on the House Financial Services Committee. Congressman Murphy also serves on the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, where he will play an important role in investigating and proposing solutions to the nation's most pressing issues, including the management of the war in Iraq, the implementation of Medicare Part D, and the need for open government.
